Other CEEC Activities & Charges
NON-RIDING COFFEE MORNINGS - \$90 for 1 adult and 1 child - additional children in same family \$45. The price includes a cup of tea or coffee, an apple juice, a chocolate bar and a lolly pop.
RIDING COFFEE MORNINGS - \$600 - Minimum 2 children. Includes coffee or tea & snack for parent, Juice & lolly for child and a 10 minutes ride. Must be booked and paid for in advance. <u>Minimum age 3 and maximum age 5.</u>
EQUIPMENT HIRE - Boots \$20/Back Protector \$30. Hats may not be hired. In the event that your hat does not fit or we consider it unsafe, we will loan you a hat at a charge of \$20. There is no charge for equipment loan to non-members, birthday parties, camp attendees and debenture holders. Members MUST own their own hats. Hats will be checked regularly and must adhere to our safety codes - PAS 015:1998 or EN 1384:1996 or BS EN 1384:1997. <u>Hats MUST be replaced annually.</u>
STABLE MANAGEMENT - Stable Management Lessons are offered on a private or semi private basis only. The non-member charge is \$580(P)/\$480(SP) for a 30 minute lesson and \$800(P)/\$720(SP) for a 45 minute non-member lesson. Member charges are \$440(P)/\$360(SP) for a 30 minute lesson and \$660(P)/\$540(SP) and 5 year & life members deduct 5%, debentures deduct 8%, premier and corp debentures deduct 10% off the member prices.
BHS THEORY MAKE UPS/PRIVATE or SEMI PRIVATE - The non-member charge is \$900(P)/\$750(SP) per 60 minute lesson. The member charge is \$800(P)/\$600(SP) for one year members and 5 year & life members deduct 5%, debentures deduct 8%, premier and corp debentures deduct 10% off the member prices.

LIVERY FEES (monthly)		
Privately owned horses & ponies	Min. Fee of 15,000	A minimum payment per month is required. This fee covers full livery fee (7,500), shoeing (approx. 770), vet (approx. 400) and lessons/exercise up to the minimum fee of 15,000. Contact us for full details on this. Spaces are strictly limited.
Monthly Full Livery	7,500	Monthly full livery requires that the livery holder pays all fees for the horse - this includes exercise fees when unable to ride. Horses must be exercised 6 times per week - at least one of these must be a lesson. The horse remains the property, and under the jurisdiction of, the CEEC at all times.
Three Quarter Livery	7,200	3/4 Livery Owners may ride the horse 6 times per week. At least 2 rides must be lessons. Additionally, 3/4 livery holders are responsible for 50% of shoeing charges and 50% of regular annual vet fees. 3/4 livery holders may compete.
Weekend Half Livery	4,800	May ride 4 times per week on a weekday or weekend - 1 must be a lesson charged at livery rate. 1/2 livery horses are shared with the school but livery holders have the opportunity to spend an hour prior to and post their lesson with the horse/pony. Weekend livery holders will have the opportunity to compete on a semi-regular basis.
Weekday Half Livery	4,300	May ride 4 times per week - 1 must be a lesson. 1/2 livery horses are shared with the school but livery holders have the opportunity to spend an hour prior to and post their lesson with the horse/pony. Weekday livery holders will have the opportunity to compete a maximum of 2 times per season.
Special Livery. Price includes 2 x group or P30 lessons per week	3,800	Special livery allows both children and adults with less experience to ride the same horse/pony each time they ride. The price includes time with the horse prior to and post riding and the riding lesson fee. There is no fee for tacking up or down. Add an additional \$500 per month if you wish to upgrade one lesson to P45 lessons and \$1,000 for 2.
Special Livery. Price includes 2 x group or P30 lessons per week	5,500	Special livery allows both children and adults with less experience to ride the same horse/pony each time they ride. The price includes time with the horse prior to and post riding and the riding lesson fee. There is no fee for tacking up or down. Add an additional \$500 per month if you wish to upgrade one lesson to P45 lessons and \$1,000 for 2.
Monthly Livery	7,000	This fee offers a chance for potential livery holders to trial a horse. The fee includes 4 x private 45 minute lessons. The monthly livery holder may free ride an additional 3 times per week. Extra lessons are charged at livery rate during the 1 month trial.
