Re-Vamped and Re-Vitalised Christmas Camps and Holiday Activities

NEW STYLE CAMPS - We have re-vamped our camps and there will be a varierty of camps offered during the Christmas holidays. Theses camps will feature new activities such as tent pegging, barrel racing, gymkhana games, natural horsemanship, how to build a showjumping course (and how to jump one!), road sense (how to ride on the roads) plus lots of other activities and new skills not yet taught at the CEEC camps.

1/2-Day Camp - 9:00 am to 1:00 pm

Monday, December 16th --/-- Wednesday, December 18th Tuesday, December 24th --/-- Friday, December 27th Age: 6 and over.

1-Day Camp - 10:00 am to 4:00 pm

- COMPETITION CAMP

 We will also have one camp which is dedicated to competing and preparing for competitions. This day will be hugely beneficial for anyone wishing to compete at home or away in the future but will also be fun for anyone with a competitive streak as it will feature a mini competition. This camp runs from 8:00 am to 7:00 pm as you will be preparing and practising for your show and then tucking your pony/horse into bed! The fee for this camp is \$2000 for members (with usual discounts) and \$2,500 for non members. The date of this camp is Thursday, January 2nd please contact Sarah for full details. Numbers will be limited and all levels are welcome.
- PARENT AND CHILD 1/2 DAY CAMP Due to members requests, we will be offering a parent & child ½ day competition camp on Friday, January 3rd from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. There will be an adult and child competition featuring gymkhana games (mounted and unmounted) and an agiity course with a mini show. Turn out of horse and rider is also key although the number 14 must be included most creative (yet practical!) Wins. Adults pay ½ day rate child goes free! Open to all riders as instructors will be on hand to guide you along the way if required.
- Lots of mums have mentioned that they fancy returning to or haviing a crack at riding. We have been working with all the other riding schools in Hong Kong and are pleased to announce that we will be competing against each other. Teams will be made up of 3 members that are 10, 11 or 12. In order to give more children the chance to compete, we will be altering the team each time.

Cancellations for Clinics

We have had a large amount of cancellations for international clinics. These clinics take a huge amount of organization and are offered as a member privilege. When organizing the outside trainers, we pay a very large daily rate in addition to travel costs and have to plan and budget for this several months in advance to ensure that we cover our costs. Whilst we appreciate that you would prefer to ride particular horses or your own livery horse, horses are not always predictable and

you may have to ride an alternative horse. With immediate effect, a non-refundable 50% will be charged at the time of booking with the balance due two weeks prior to the lesson. No refunds will be offered after the final fee is paid although <u>you</u> may personally find a fill in (of the same level if in a semi-private or group lesson) if you are unable to attend at the last minute.

Please also be aware that we have received complaints about other clients watching these lessons. Only group lessons may be observed by non-family members when out of town trainers are in attendance. I am sure you appreciate that they are expensive and not everyone is comfortable being watched or asking another member not to watch. We would really apreciate your understanding and cooperation with this.


